Using main applications

This section describes how to use of main applications.

For details on the use of each application software, refer to "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

Viewing handwritten memos and image files


You can use **CLIE Viewer** to view handwritten memos, image files saved on your CLIÉ handheld or "Memory Stick" media. Different kinds of file are displayed in date order. This makes it easier to find the file you want to display or play back.

- Application to be used: CLIE Viewer
- Data to be used:
 - Image files: JPEG (DCF) format, PictureGear Pocket format
 - Handwritten memos
- → For details on the file format you can play back or view with your CLIÉ handheld, refer to "CLIE Viewer" in "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

Opening/Playing back files

1 Select (CLIE Viewer) in the CLIE Launcher to start CLIE Viewer.

The file list screen is displayed.



2 Select the file you want to display by rotating the Jog Dial™ navigator or pressing ☐ / ☐ (the Left/Right buttons), them press the Jog Dial™ navigator.

The selected file is displayed.

Tips

- · You can also tap the file icon to display the file.
- The files are listed in order of creation date and time.

Deleting files

You can delete image files on your CLIÉ handheld or "Memory Stick" media from the list screen of **CLIE Viewer**.

Note

For handwritten memos (note files), delete from the list screen of **CLIE Memo**.

- 1 Start CLIE Viewer.
- **2** Tap (Delete).
 - \square is displayed at the top left of each file.

Delete button



3 Tap the check box of the file to select.

Tip

Tap [Select All] to select all the files.

4 Tap [OK].

The selected file is deleted.

Listening to music (for PEG-TJ35 only)

You can play back music files in MP3 format on your CLIÉ handheld.

- Application to be used:
 - Transfer music files in MP3 format: **Data Import**, **Data Export** (for PC)
 - Play back music file on your CLIÉ handheld: AeroPlayer for CLIE
- Required accessories and media: Headphones (not supplied), "Memory Stick" media
- Data to be used: MP3

Transferring music file to your CLIÉ handheld

You can transfer music file via "Memory Stick" media from your computer to your CLIÉ handheld.


Tip

You can transfer music file in MP3 format with **Data Import** and **Data Export** via "Memory Stick" media.

Playing back music file

- 1 Transfer the music file in MP3 format you want to listen from your computer to your CLIÉ handheld via "Memory Stick" media.
- **2** Connect the headphones to your CLIÉ handheld.



Note

Use the headphones with a stereo mini jack plug.

Tap (AeroPlayer for CLIE) on the CLIE Launcher on your CLIÉ handheld. AeroPlayer for CLIE starts.



4 Tap (Playback) to play music. Tap (Stop) to stop the music.



Managing schedules (Date Book)

You can save the date and times of your schedules.

You can efficiently manage your schedules, such as conferences or business trips.

- · Application to be used: Date Book
- → For details, refer to "Date Book" in "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

Entering a schedule


1 Press (the Date Book button) on your CLIÉ handheld to start **Date Book**.





You can also tap (Date Book) on the CLIE Launcher to start Date Book.

- **2** Tap [New] and set the start time and end time of the schedule.
 - 1 Tap to set the start time.
 - 2 Tap to set the end time.
 - 3 Tap to select "hour".
 - 4 Tap to select "minute".
 - 5 Tap to confirm the settings.



3 Enter an event.

Deleting an event

- 1 Tap an event you want to delete and tap (Menu). The menu screen is displayed.
- **2** Tap [Delete Event...] from [Record]. The confirmation message is displayed.



3 Tap [OK].

Tip

When the check box next to [Save archive copy on PC] on the **Delete Event** screen is **Y**, the deleted data from your CLIÉ handheld will be stored on your computer at the next HotSync operation.

To view the saved data on your computer, open Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ, and select [Open Archive...] in [File] of the Date Book screen.

Managing addresses and telephone numbers (Address Book)


You can register information such as names, addresses, telephone numbers and an image attachment.

You can set your Address Book record as Name Card, and send the Address Book record to another CLIÉ handheld or Palm OS[®] compatible device by beaming.

- · Application to be used: Address Book
- ▶ For details, refer to "Address Book" in "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format).

Entering a new address

1 Press (a) (the Address Book button) on your CLIÉ handheld to start Address Book.



2 Tap [New]. The Address Edit screen is displayed.



3 Tap each item and enter details.





You can scroll the screen by tapping \blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown at the bottom right or rotating the Jog DialTM navigator.

Deleting an address entry

- 1 Tap the address you want to delete and tap (Menu). The menu screen is displayed.
- **2** Tap [Delete Address...] from [Record]. The confirmation message is displayed.



3 Tap [OK].

Tip

When the check box next to [Save archive copy on PC] on the **Delete Address** screen is **Y**, the deleted data from your CLIÉ handheld will be stored on your computer at the next HotSync operation.

To view the saved data on your computer, open Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ, and select [Open Archive...] in [File] of the Address Book screen.

Exchanging Date Book and Address Book data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer

The HotSync® operation enables you to exchange Date Book data and the Address Book data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer.

Depending on the software on your computer, there are two ways to exchange data.

Exchanging data between your CLIÉ handheld and the Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ software on your computer

You can synchronize data between **Date Book** or **Address Book** managed by **PalmTM Desktop for CLIÉ** on your computer, and your CLIÉ handheld.

- Setup: You need to install Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ on your computer.
- ➡ For details on how to exchange data with Palm™ Desktop for CLIÉ, refer to "Synchronizing data between your CLIÉ handheld and computer (HotSync®)" in "Read This First (Operating Instructions)".

Exchanging data between your CLIÉ handheld and Microsoft[®] Outlook (Intellisync[®] Lite) on your computer

- **Setup**: You need to install **Intellisync Lite** on your computer.
- For details on how to install, refer to "Intellisync Lite" in "CLIÉ Application Manual" (HTML format)

Tip

Intellisync Lite can be installed by clicking [CLIÉ Data Management] on the Installation CD-ROM screen of the installation CD-ROM and following the on-screen instructions.

→ For details on how to start and set up, refer to the help text of Intellisync Lite. To view the help text, click [Start], select [Programs] (for Windows XP, select [All Programs]) - [Intellisync Lite] - and click [Intellisync Help].

Viewing documents on your CLIÉ handheld (Picsel Viewer for CLIE) (for PEG-TJ35 only)

You can view documents created in Microsoft[®] Word/Excel/PowerPoint[®] or PDF files on your CLIÉ handheld.

- Application to be used: Picsel Viewer for CLIE, Data Import and Data Export (for PC)
- Required media: "Memory Stick" media
- Data to be viewed from Picsel Viewer for CLIE: doc format, xls format, ppt format, txt format, JPEG format, GIF format, PNG format, BMP format, PDF format, HTML format
- Setup:
 - ① You need to connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer.
 - → For details, refer to "Using your CLIÉ™ handheld with your computer" in "Read This First (Operating Instructions)".
 - 2 You need to install **Data Export** on your computer.
 - For details, refer to "Installing the supplied applications on your CLIÉ handheld" in "Read This First (Operating Instructions)".

Transferring the documents to your CLIÉ handheld

- 1 Prepare the documents on your computer that you wish to view on your CLIÉ handheld.
- **2** Connect your CLIÉ handheld to your computer with a USB cable.
- 3 Insert the "Memory Stick" media into your CLIÉ handheld.





Viewing the documents (for PEG-TJ35 only)

1 Select (PicselViewer) in the CLIE Launcher to start Picsel Viewer for CLIE.



2 Tap (Carousel) at the bottom right of the screen. The Carousel menu screen is displayed.



3 Tap **3** (Folder View), then tap the document you want to view from the "Memory Stick" media.

The document is displayed.

Supplied applications

Types of applications

There are three types of applications and two types of symbols:

- · Applications already installed on your CLIÉ handheld
- · Applications you need to install on your CLIÉ handheld
- · Applications you need to install on your computer



Appearing to the right of application names.



: An application run by your CLIÉ handheld.



: An application which must be installed on your computer and is run by your computer.


